

## Teach SouthEast Initial Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for Teach SouthEast's Initial Teacher Training (ITT) programme, you will need the following qualifications:

- 5 GCSEs (or acceptable equivalent) – Grade A\*- C (new gradings 4-9) which must include Maths & English
- A-Level in related subject preferable
- Degree - 2:2 or above

We will need to see your original degree, A-level and GCSE certificates. If you do not have these, you will need to contact the appropriate examination board for duplicates. If you do not have Maths and English GCSE or a recognised equivalent, you will need to sit an equivalency test with Equivalency Testing. For more information, please visit the website:

If your degree or high school education was undertaken outside the UK, you will need to obtain a statement of comparability from NARIC: <https://www.naric.org.uk/naric/>

There are 3 Pathways, Core SCITT, School Direct Non Salaried & School Direct Salaried. To be eligible for a School Direct Salaried position you will need to have at least 3 years' relevant work experience and comprehensive subject knowledge. Core SCITT & School Direct Non-Salaried both carry a £9,000 tuition fee, but both are eligible for government-funded bursaries, dependant on subject and degree classification.
